**Nottingham City Council (Harvey Road Area, Bilborough, Nottingham)
(Prohibitions of Waiting and Parking Places) Traffic Regulation Order 2018 (TMP 7250)**



Dear Parent / Carer,

We have been liaising with Nottingham City Council and other Harvey Road users for a long time in order to improve safety on Harvey Road. We were pleased to receive a letter this week to say that they have sent out their proposals as part of a consultation with a view to the work being completed later this year.

These proposals aim to reduce vehicles parking on the pavement and blocking access points which causes visibility concerns for pedestrians and access to the schools/other areas. To address this and protect the safety of pedestrians on the footway, it is proposed to implement 'No Waiting at Any Time' (double yellow lines) to prohibit parking and allow the free flow of traffic on the road and footways. The double yellow lines will be extended to the entrances to Bluecoat Beechdale Academy and Glenbrook Primary School. The current double yellow lines have not been enforceable but will be if this proposal is successful.

To further aid pedestrian safety, school entrance clearways will be introduced on Harvey Road in front of the pedestrian access gate to the Bluecoat Beechdale Academy and in front of the entrance to the Bluecoat Primary Academy. The clearways will be operational Monday – Friday, 8.30 – 9.30 am and 2.30 – 4.00 pm.

Unrestricted parking on the carriageway will be permitted where possible to regulate the current parking situation. A formal disabled parking bay will be introduced opposite Bluecoat Primary Academy to replace the current advisory disabled parking bay.

By introducing these proposals, all road users will have greater visibility at junctions and ease of access in these areas. A plan of these proposals is attached to this letter.

Before proceeding with this proposal, Nottingham City Council would like to consider your views regarding this matter. Whilst it may not be possible to agree to all your suggestions, they will incorporate your ideas into the proposals whenever appropriate and economically feasible.
